Scope of Services: Laboratory services will be provided in support of the roadway widening project along SW 137th Avenue from SW 8th Street to SW 26th Street (approximately 1.17 miles). Services will consist primarily of laboratory materials testing, including earthwork sample testing, concrete compressive strength testing, and asphalt mixture testing, as required by the project specifications. All testing will be performed in accordance with applicable standards and procedures to verify compliance with contract requirements. Laboratory analyses and certified test reports will be issued upon completion of the required testing.				
Deliverables and approx. completion dates: Deliverables will include certified laboratory test reports for earthwork materials, concrete compressive strength testing, and asphalt mixture testing, as required by the project specifications. Concrete compressive strength reports will be issued upon completion of the required curing period (typically 28 days), unless early break results are requested. All other laboratory reports will be submitted following completion of testing in accordance with applicable standards and procedures.				
Factors that may impact the project scope and schedule: The scope and schedule of laboratory services may be affected by the timing and frequency of sample delivery, changes in the Contractor's construction sequence, weather-related delays impacting material placement, and requests for additional testing or retesting. Variations in material quantities, non-conforming test results requiring further analysis, incomplete or delayed documentation, and revisions to project specifications may also impact laboratory workload and report issuance timelines. Additionally, specialized testing requiring subcontracted laboratory services may influence turnaround times based on availability and coordination.
