

PROJECT OVERVIEW



The Greater Miami Expressway Agency (GMX) has advance a lighting improvement project along State Road 878/Snapper Creek Expressway from US-1 to 874/Don Shula Expressway. The project includes upgrading the existing High-Pressure Sodium (HPS)

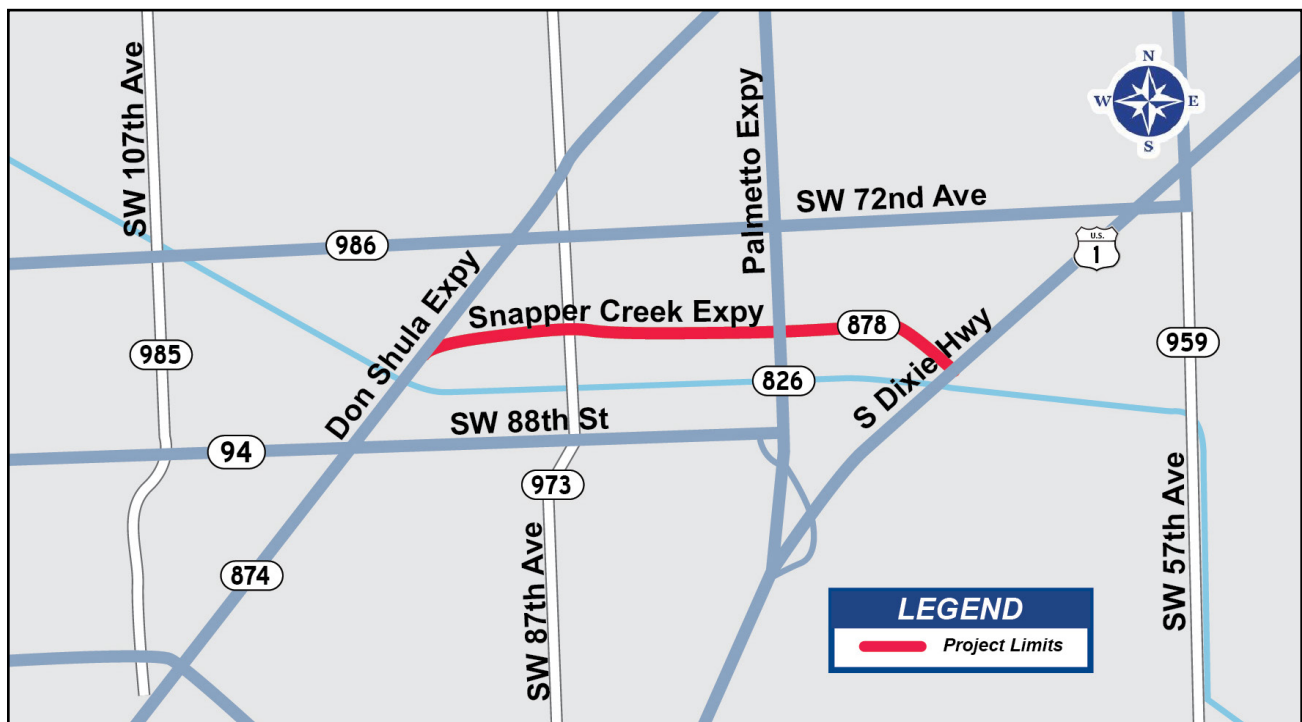
lighting system to a new Smart Lighting System using Light-Emitting Diode (LED) luminaires. Additional work includes modifying existing concrete bridge railings to support new light pole installation, sidewalk, curb and gutter work, as well as tree removal and relocation. This project will require temporary lane and shoulder closures along SR 878 and intersecting roadways.

- Project Type: Safety Improvements / Smart LED Lighting and Roadway Safety Improvements
- Project Cost: \$6,950,000

- Estimated Completion: Early Summer 2028

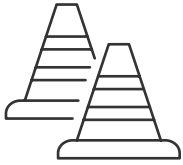

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

Single lane closures at SW 87th Avenue are scheduled intermittently, Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., for underground utility work.

Sidewalk closures and pedestrian detours will be in place at various intersections along SW 72nd Avenue and SW 87th Avenue including:

SW 72nd Avenue:

- at SE 80th Street
- at SR 878/Snapper Creek Expressway entrance/exit ramp
- at SW 82nd Street

SW 87th Avenue:

- SW 72nd Street
- at SR 878/Snapper Creek Expressway entrance/exit ramp
- at SW 82nd Street

Please note that closures will not occur simultaneously. Moderate levels of noise, dust in the air, and traffic delays can be expected. Drivers are asked to use the alternate routes provided.
